PURPOSE:

To adopt Policy GBEAA as previously studied at the October 23, 2012 Board meeting.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Any employee who has or whose relative has a substantial interest in any decision of the District, including a decision to employ the relative or to engage in business with the relative, shall make known this interest in the Official records of the District, and shall refrain from participating in any manner as an employee in such a decision.

This existing policy adopted in 2004 and revised in 2007 was based on the ASBA Model. Additional language is being added to emphasize the disclosure of a conflict of interest. This new language is underlined. The rules concerning tutoring are covered in ASBA Model Policy GCRD - Tutoring for Pay, which is recommended to be adopted along with this policy.

Policy has been reviewed by the Policy Subcommittee, the Legal Department and posted on the Governing Board website.

Members of the Policy Subcommittee will be available to answer questions.
