PURPOSE:

To present a status report to the Governing Board on the energy savings efforts and rebates on the Mary Belle McCorkle Academy of Excellence K-8 project.

Marcus E. Jones, R.A., Program Manager for Bonds and Architecture will be available to answer questions and to make a presentation to the Governing Board.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

As the District's newest school and our model for 21st century education, McCorkle was designed to include many examples of sustainable building design. These features are present on the campus not only as a part of the building systems, but also in a way to be examples for the students to see as a part of their lives. The campus has daylighting technics, water harvesting, economizing lighting controls and both solar water heating and solar photovoltaic panels.

Another benefit of these systems is the potential for energy rebates. Earlier this year, Tucson Electric Power issued a rebate check in the amount of \$28,983.38 for the solar water systems. Tonight Bonds and Architecture is proud to announce that a rebate for the photvoltaic panels has been received in the amount of \$157,684.80.

An enlarged version of the check will be presented to the Governing Board President.

This item relates to Superintendent Goal No. 1 - Student Achievement. Upgrade of this facility will support achievement by improving the physical environment in response to the academic programming needs for our students.
