# PPEL 101 - Review

- December 17, 2015 Course Code issued in Mojave.
- Fall, 2017 Questions arise regarding the course.
  - Is the course Board approved?
  - ■Is the course for Economics or Elective Credit?
- Secondary Leadership and Advanced Learning Experiences initiate an audit of all courses.

## Course Audit Results

- PHIL 101, now PPEL 101, and other courses are unapproved and have students enrolled in them.
   Curriculum & Instruction Department compiles the list and bring to the Governing Board.
- January 30, 2018 Governing Board approves courses.
- January 30, 2018 Governing Board also approves new Course Approval Flowchart. New Flowchart does not allow a course code to be issued before the course is Board approved.

# Course Audit Results

- PHIL 101 Resolution passed by Tucson Unified Governing Board granting credit for students enrolled in PHIL 101 for 2016-17 and 2017-18 School Year.
- →PHIL 101/PPEL 101 not offered in 2018-19.

# PPEL Course Request

- The Curriculum & Instruction and Advanced Learning Experiences departments were asked to bring PPEL 101 to the Governing Board for consideration as a High School Elective Course.
- Students who successfully complete the course are eligible to receive credit for the course from The University of Arizona.
