Early Childhood Care Specialists report to work at the Brichta and Schumaker centers during the winter and rodeo breaks based on student enrollment. Employees are paid for the designated holidays in addition to pay for time and a half for actual hours worked during this time. A review of the financial impact this practice has on the sites was completed and it was determined that it is not feasible for the District to continue in this manner.
