Current Policy IKFB requires a cap and gown for all students participating in High School graduation exercises, and allows only for approved honor cords to be worn as adornment. Governing Board Clerk Ms. Foster proposes making accommodations for students who wish to wear garments reflecting their religious and/or cultural background, with the approval of the Superintendent or designee. The Superintendent would be authorized to develop a process for making such a request.
