# The Facts About Injury, Trauma and Violence

---

- ❖ 41 million Emergency Room Visits
- ❖ 6.3 million fractures
- ❖ 35,000 fatalities from motor vehicle accidents
- ❖ 2006-2018 Active Violence Incidents: 160% increase
- ❖ Trauma: The leading cause of death from ages 1-46
- ❖ Approximately 140,000 deaths every year in the U.S.
- ❖ 39% of these premature deaths are **preventable**

*We strongly believe the public can and should act as immediate responders to stop bleeding from all hazards, including active shooter and intentional mass casualty events...*









- ❖ Teaches the Public proper Bleeding Control techniques
- ❖ Arizona Stop The Bleed Coalition



# Bleeding Control for the Injured (B-Con)



- ❖ Developed by NAEMT's PHTLS Committee
- ❖ Program adopted and enhanced by ACS
- ❖ Goal to increase collaboration between public safety and the community
- ❖ Proactive bystander education and response saves lives





# Bleeding Control for the Injured (B-Con)



Teaches participants the following basic life-saving medical interventions:

- ❖ B-Con with a tourniquet
- ❖ B-Con with gauze packs or bleeding control agents
- ❖ Airway opening to allow a casualty to breathe



- ❖ Coalition's Number One Priority: Train TUSD
- ❖ 12 month goal: Provide all educators, administrators, middle and high school students with this life-saving instruction
- ❖ Flexible training schedules match *your* individual or organization's *unique* personal and professional development needs
- ❖ Will come to YOU!!


