## **Alternatives to PE Requirements**

## INFORMATION/APPLICATION

Upon completion of an entire season of one of the sports/programs listed below, a student may qualify
to demonstrate proficiency in the area of Physical Education by requesting to test. The following
competitive TUSD sports/programs have been approved as alternative pathways to earn Physical
Education credit:

The TUSD sports/activity must provide a training/competition schedule with a minimum of 15 hours per week participation for the high school student.

- 2. At the completion of the season, documentation maintained by the student <u>and</u> verified by the parent/guardian and the coach must be submitted to the school counselor for processing.
- Students being awarded PE Alternative Credit through participation in a school sponsored extracurricular activity
  - a. must be academically eligible at the end of the sports/activity season
  - b. must participate for the entirety of the sports/activity season
  - c. Credit will only be awarded upon successful completion of the following:
    - i. Attendance & Performance Record submitted with all required signatures
    - ii. Written Exam: 60% score
    - iii. Performance Exam: 75% score (passing 4 of 6 physical activities)
