For Magnet Schools and Application Schools* Only: To be eligible for first-round lottery selection, you must apply by January 8, 2021.

Parents may enroll in magnet and application schools directly online once an application acceptance letter is received.

Parents may enroll in other schools directly online starting February 1, 2021.

2. All mailings are time sensitive. **Parents/guardians must notify the school to update a change of address in their student's record.**
3. Magnet schools/programs are subject to modification. Affected parents/guardians will be informed immediately if this occurs.
4. Free transportation is available for in-District magnet students, qualified open enrollment students (see tusd1.org/schoolchoice), and neighborhood students living more than 1.5 miles away (for elementary & K8 schools) or 2.5 miles away (for middle & high schools).
