- 3. Magnet schools/programs are subject to modification. Affected parents/guardians will be informed immediately if this occurs.
- Free transportation is available for in-District magnet students, qualified open enrollment students (see tusd1.org/schoolchoice), and neighborhood students living more than 1 mile away (for elementary & K8 schools) or 2.5 miles away (for middle & high schools).
